

Emergency Salbutamol Kit Checklist

(minimum 2 kits per school)

An emergency asthma inhaler kit should include:	Yes	No	Checked by / Date
One salbutamol metered dose inhaler			
Once used, the inhaler casing should be washed			
and dried as per manufacturer instructions and can			
be used again			
At least two single-use plastic spacers.			
Once used, the plastic spacer should be sent home with the child with a request that the family replace it. It should not be used by another child. In the meantime, the school should replace the spacer			
Instructions on using the inhaler and spacer			
A checklist of inhalers.			
Identified by their batch number and expiry date, with half termly monthly checks recorded			
A note of the arrangements for replacing the			
inhaler and spacers			
A list of children permitted to use the			
emergency inhaler.			
(as detailed in their individual healthcare plans or asthma register with consent recorded)			
A record of administration			
(i.e. when the inhaler has been used).			
Instructions for disposing of the used inhaler
